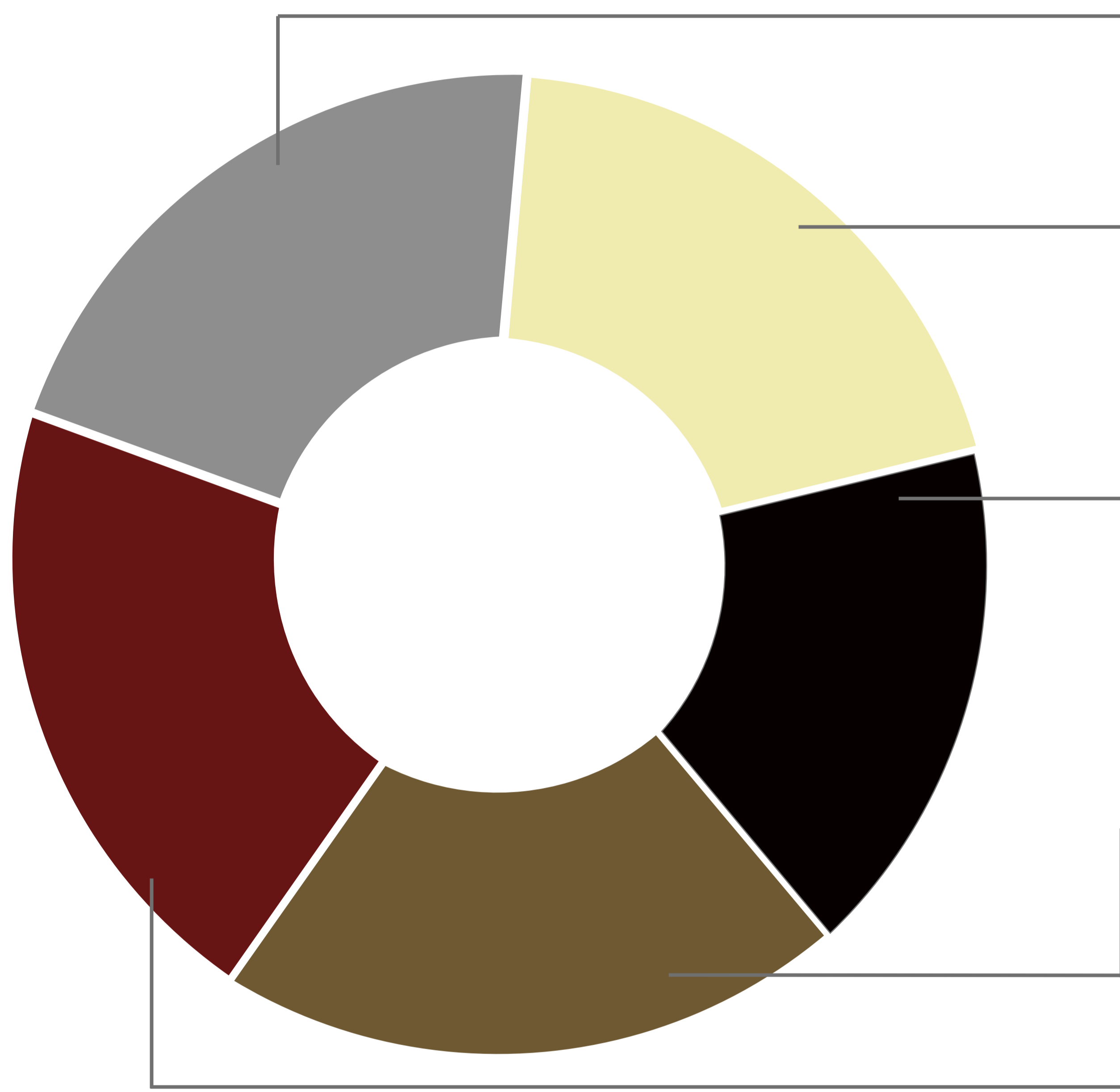


WHAT DOES THE COLOUR AND TEXTURE OF YOUR EARWAX MEAN?



GREY

This generally indicates older wax.

OFF-WHITE/ YELLOW

This indicates fresh earwax. Earwax of this colour is likely found deep in the ear canal.

BLACK

This colour can indicate that your eardrum is perforated which can lead to infection. It is recommended to visit a healthcare professional in this case.

BROWN

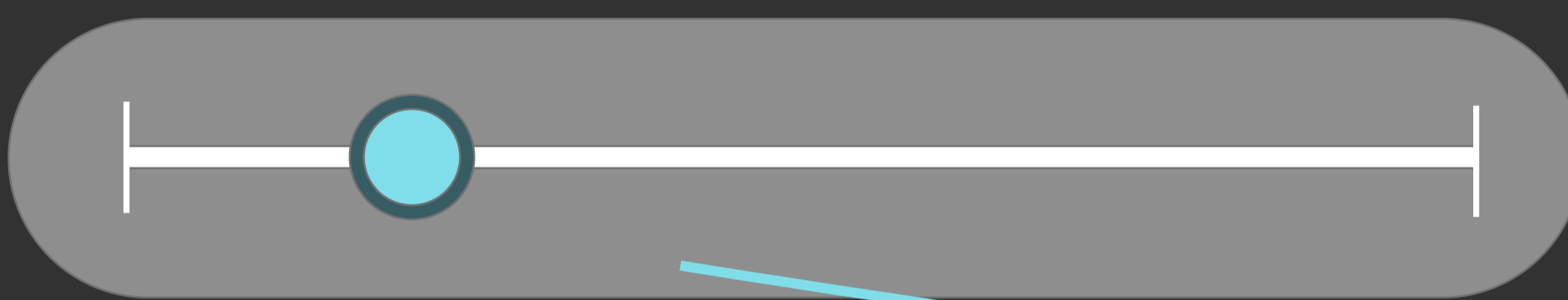
This is common among city dwellers due to pollution and dust and is nothing to worry about.

TRACES OF BLOOD

This indicates impacted earwax, which can be painful and could, in some cases, be associated with mild hearing loss and/or tinnitus.

BAD ODOUR



NO ODOUR

Indication of a possible ear infection.

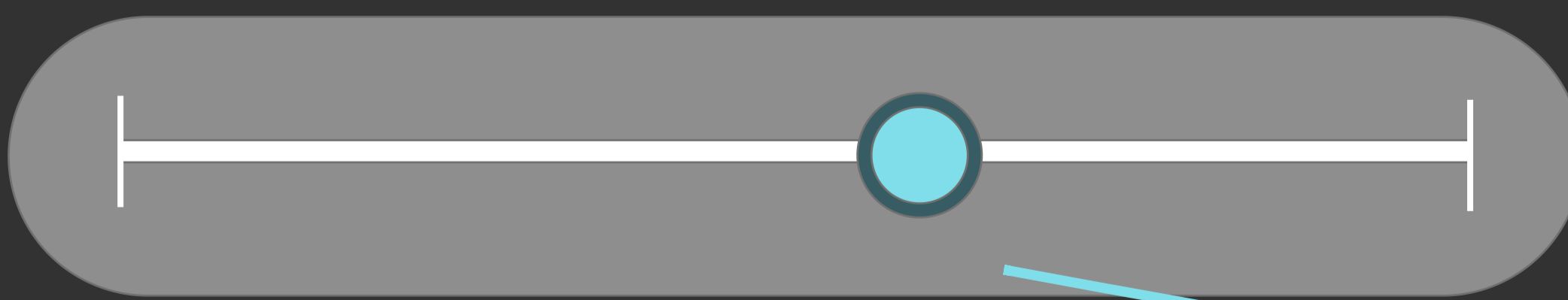
MIN DISCHARGE



MAX DISCHARGE

Generally a sign of a stressful lifestyle.

WET EARWAX



DRY EARWAX

A sudden change in consistency could indicate initial stages of inflammation.
